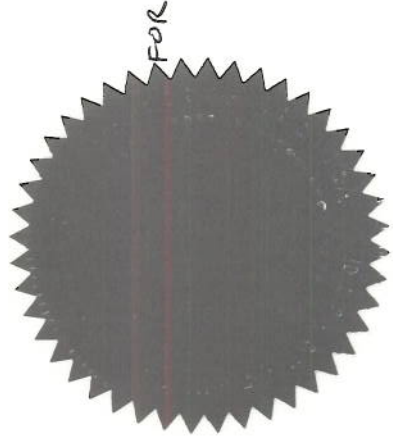
This is to certify that Biologics License No. 1274 is hereby issued
